Recent amendments to the code of conduct are highlighted in red for your convenience.

All participants in the Global Rally Championship (GRC) are expected to adhere to the following Code of Conduct at all times. This Code applies to all aspects of the championship, including rounds, official communication channels and any other interactions related to the GRC.

1. General Principles

- I. Sportsmanship:** Participants must conduct themselves with integrity, fairness, and respect towards other participants, organizers, and spectators.
- II. Fair Play:** Participants must compete fairly and avoid any form of cheating, exploitation, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- III. Respectful Communication:** Participants must communicate respectfully and avoid any form of harassment, abuse, discrimination, or offensive language.

2. Specific Conduct Guidelines

- I. Communication Channels:**
 - i. Respectful Language:** Refrain from using offensive language, hate speech, personal attacks, or any other form of harassment.
 - ii. Constructive Communication:** Engage in constructive discussions and avoid spreading rumors or misinformation.
 - iii. No Spamming or Trolling:** Avoid spamming messages or engaging in disruptive behavior.

- iv. **Respect for Privacy:** Do not share private information about other participants without their consent.

3. Prohibited Behaviors

The following behaviors are strictly prohibited and will result in penalties, up to and including disqualification from the championship:

- I. Cheating and Exploitation:** As defined in Section 8 of the rulebook.
- II. Harassment and Abuse:** Any form of verbal or written harassment, including personal attacks, insults, threats, or discriminatory language.
- III. Discrimination:** Any form of discrimination based on race, ethnicity, gender, religion, sexual orientation, disability, or any other protected characteristic.
- IV. Profanity and Offensive Language:** Excessive use of profanity or offensive language.
- V. Impersonation:** Impersonating other participants, organizers, or any other individual.
- VI. Spreading Misinformation:** Spreading false or misleading information that could harm the championship or its participants.
- VII. Unsportsmanlike Conduct:** Any behavior that is deemed unsportsmanlike or detrimental to the spirit of fair competition.

4. Enforcement and Penalties

- I. Reporting Violations:** Participants who witness or experience violations of this Code of Conduct should report them to the championship organizers with appropriate action.
- II. Investigation Process:** The organizers will investigate all reported violations and take appropriate action.
- III. Penalties:** Penalties for violating the Code of Conduct may include, but are not limited to:
 - i. **Verbal Warning:** A formal warning for minor infractions.
 - ii. **Time Penalty:** A time penalty added to the participant's rally time.
 - iii. **Stage Disqualification:** Disqualification from a specific stage.
 - iv. **Event Disqualification:** Disqualification from a specific event.
 - v. **Championship Disqualification:** Disqualification from the championship.
 - vi. **Ban from Future Events:** Banning the participant from future DYNMC Motorsport events.

By participating in the Global Rally Championship, all participants agree to abide by this Code of Conduct. DYNMC Motorsport reserves the right to modify this Code of Conduct at any time.
